

INTENSIVE LATIN

Learn Latin in two 10 week courses, 2 nights a week. No previous knowledge of Latin necessary. Ages 18+

THE WISDOM OF POSSIBILITY

THEOLOGICAL LITERACY

Deepen your understanding of the Christian faith by considering the Trinity, Christology, atonement, and grace through readings of primary texts written at decisive moments in the development of those doctrines.

Students will be led to reflect on ideas like beauty, power, friendship, wonder, and joy through books, both classic and popular, that feature dragons.
